Uniform Dress Code

DAY UNIFORM

- Culottes for Intermediate (Years 7-8)
- Skirt for Junior (Years 9-10) and Senior (Years 11-13)
- Short sleeved striped shirt (long sleeved shirt is optional)
- Jersey
- Blazer
- Tie
- Black dress shoes with black footlets in summer and black, opaque, 70 denier tights in winter
- Panama hat in summer

DRESS UNIFORM

- All students must wear their blazer and tie every Friday, at Sunday Chapel, on the first and last day of each term and on special occasions.
- Boarders must wear their blazer and tie when traveling to and from school at the beginning and end of each term.

EXPECTATIONS

- Girls are expected to wear their uniform with pride. All uniform is constantly checked for a general state of cleanliness and repair.
- No make-up or nail polish is to be worn; this includes mufti days.
- The jersey may not be worn as the outer garment in public.
- Hair must be tied back with black, brown or maroon elastic ties. No 'extreme' styles. Hair bands or clips may be worn in tortoiseshell, brown or black to keep hair off the face. No sparkly bands or fashion 'fake' hairpieces.
- Hair colour must be within each girl's natural hair colour range.
- Undergarments must be white, cream, or skin coloured.
- One small ear 'stud' may be worn in each ear lobe in silver, gold, pearl or garnet. No necklaces, rings or bracelets. No jewellery is to be worn with the sports uniform.
- Offending items such as non-regulation jewellery will be confiscated until the end of term.

SCHOOL MUFTI

For occasions that require mufti, the dress is smart casual. Mufti occasions include mufti days, themed school days – including Year 13 sports day costumes, School Socials, House Drama, House Music and House debate events, whether attending as a performer or a member of the audience. Sleepwear, i.e. pyjamas, are not appropriate attire. Make-up and nail polish are not permitted at school mufti occasions and may only be worn at school socials. No face/body paint is permitted.

How to purchase the uniform

- The Uniform Shop Manager will invite all families for a fitting before the end of the school year.
- Your daughter's uniform will be ordered and delivered to your home address if she is a boarder. If your daughter is a day girl, you will be able to collect her uniform from the School. We will contact you upon delivery.
- Invoices will be sent upon delivery/collection of the uniform.
- Payments can be made by cash, EFTPOS, cheque, online transfer (bank account details will be provided by Uniform Shop Manager) or credit card. Please note there is a 3% charge for credit card.
- Shoes are available from Lee James Footwear, 17 Middle Road in Havelock North (McKinlay "Rio" for up to size 5; "Kristen" for sizes 5-11).



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can we mix the old and new uniform items together?

A. No. Girls may only wear all new or all old. This includes the Physical Education uniform.

Q. Do we have to use Wovina labels?

A. No but they are our preferred supplier.

Q. How will we distinguish a Year 13 student from a Year 12 student if they have the same uniform?

A. Year 13 will wear a special Year 13 or Prefect pocket. Year 11 and Year 12 students will wear the same senior tie. This is the only additional uniform item that will need to be purchased at Year 13 level.

Q. Will the Uniform Shop continue to offer a second-hand uniform service?

A. Yes, but only for the new style of uniform. Therefore, this service will not be available until 2019.

Q. Are you going to replace/introduce other uniform items in the future?

The Physical Education and sports uniform will be reviewed in 2018. We will notify the community when more information is available.
